This post-graduate level course addresses key issues including:

Leadership and Management

Introduction to Accounting

Organisational Development

Governance



Time

Students will need to commit to 18 days over the 2 semesters which run between September 2019 and June 2020.



Costs

London Housing Foundation will cover 50% of the costs of the course for each student and can offer additional assistance if this is necessary. No organisation will pay more than £1350 per student.

Cumberland Lodge

The course starts with a two day residential at the beautiful Cumberland Lodge in Windsor Great Park. As well as a chance to get to know others on the course, this is a good opportunity to hear from high profile guest speakers.

Professional Development Programme

Graduates of the course are eligible for the LHF-funded Professional Development Programme. There is a range of one day courses covering presentation skills, dealing with the media, crisis communications, social media and negotiating and influencing. Graduates can also apply for a study trip bursary.
