TIME

Students will need to commit to 18 days over the two semesters which run from September 2024 to June 2025 plus self-directed study.



COST

London Housing Foundation will cover 50% of the costs of the course for each student and can offer additional assistance if this is necessary. Each organisation will pay £1200 per student.
